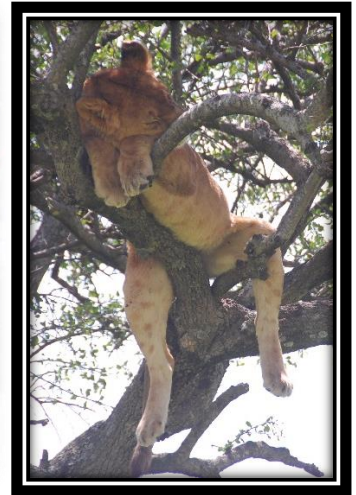


CULTURE & WILDLIFE OF KENYA

Pricing (check website for most current)

Land-Only: \$3,699 (traveler must arrange their own airfare; Kenya airport transfers \$50 to/from)

With-Air: appx \$5,959 (price depends on preferred US gateway city; includes airport transfers in Kenya)

Included: lodging (10 nights hotel/lodge; 2 in airplane); breakfast daily, 9 lunches and dinners; sightseeing tour and 7 game drives; expert tour guide/driver

Not included: passport/visa costs; meals in transit; medical/travel insurance (optional); college credits; \$100-120 guide/driver tip \$; miscellaneous spending; snacks & beverages not included with meals
