- A 2.50 minimum overall GPA required for graduation.
- At least: 60 hours at a four-year institution; 30 hours completed at OSU; 15 of the final 30 or 50% of the upper-division
 hours in the major field completed at OSU. Limit of: one-half of major course requirements as transfer work; one-fourth of
 hours earned by correspondence; 8 transfer correspondence hours.
